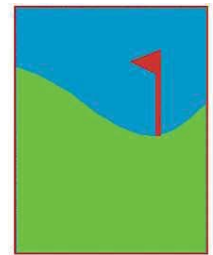

Meet Olivia Lambert *and be inspired....*



Olivia Lambert is a bright and happy local 7 year old girl with an infectious smile and a fun loving spirit.

She also suffers from neuroblastoma, a rare and very aggressive childhood cancer. Affecting around one in 100,000 children and most common in children under the age of five, neuroblastoma affects the nervous system.

Olivia was initially diagnosed with the disease in September 2006 when she was just over two and a half years old. After many rounds of intensive chemotherapy, an autologous bone marrow transplant and radiation, Olivia was placed in remission. A further 12 months of oral chemotherapy then followed but despite this intensive treatment, Olivia relapsed in April, 2008. Her prognosis was grim and doctors gave her just 6 to 9 months to live; however, being the little fighter she is and with further rounds of chemotherapy and radiotherapy, miraculously Olivia once again went into remission for almost two years. Then sadly, on 2 July 2010, after routine scans, Olivia's doctors advised that she had once again relapsed. The only option offered to Olivia in Australia was palliative chemotherapy.



University Hospital of Greifswald in Germany

A relentless search for a cure from around the world resulted in the family relocating to the University Hospital of Greifswald in Germany in August 2010 for Olivia to undergo clinical trials employing an antibody which helps the immune system attack and kill neuroblastoma cells. Not available at the time in Australia this antibody had been widely researched and trialled in the US and had shown to improve survival by around 20 percent.

Medical treatment overseas is extraordinarily expensive and at least \$300,000 was needed to fund Olivia's treatment in Germany. A public appeal was launched in Canberra in August 2010 to raise funds to support Olivia's treatment in Germany. At the same time, the Olivia Lambert Foundation, a registered charity with tax deductibility provisions was established

"for the purpose of providing money, property or benefits to, or for the relief, maintenance, support and benefit of, Olivia Lambert and other Australian children suffering neuroblastoma or other aggressive forms of cancer and who are in necessitous circumstances".

Unfortunately after four cycles of treatment at Greifswald and some six months into the program, routine scans unfortunately disclosed that the disease had returned in Olivia's left femur. This news was devastating but not entirely unexpected given that Olivia's immune system has been significantly impaired by repeated doses of chemotherapy over the last 4 ½ years. The family returned to Australia on 13 February 2011 and Olivia is now undertaking a new chemotherapy protocol developed in Germany and being administered at Sydney Children's Hospital. Subject to further scans in coming weeks showing that Olivia is again in remission, the family will return to Germany for at least three months while Olivia undergoes MIBG radiation therapy followed by a Haploidentical Stem Cell Transplant.

Incredibly happy and a full of energy, Olivia does not know she is so desperately ill. Her enthusiasm for life and her courage and fighting spirit is inspirational. The fight to save this precious little girl's life has entered a new phase and the family again faces very substantial costs for Olivia's continuing treatment. These costs will be met by the Olivia Lambert Foundation.
